Sensitive Chaos

More concerts lined up and more radio airplay



Sensitive Chaos (aka Jim Combs) will be making several appearances in the Atlanta area in August and September (see the Aurora Coffee/Criminal Records article above) and a couple of appearances at music festivals in the fall. From October 13-20, Combs will be participating in the [Different Skies](#) Electronic Music Festival at [Arcosanti](#), Arizona that culminates with a concert performance on Saturday night, October 20 in the Arcosanti amphitheater. And a little closer to home, on November 3, Sensitive

Chaos will be a featured performer at [Space Rock Con](#) in Cullman, Alabama.

This year's show will be held 3 hours from Atlanta at the Bakers Entertainment Center in Downtown Cullman, Alabama on Nov. 3rd.

SPACE ROCK CON started in 2000 and has featured the likes of NIK TURNER and HARVEY BAINBRIDGE OF HAWKWIND, BOB HARVEY (the founding member of Jefferson Airplane), and SPACESEED. The roster for this year's show includes WEERD, UNUS MUNDUS, SUBLIMINATOR, U.E.M. (WILLIAM S. HARRINGTON), WE CAN AND WE MUST, SENSITIVE CHAOS, HOTEL HOTEL, VAMPIRIC ADDICTIVE, VESSELS OF THE DIVINE, TAKEN, HART DEER, WOODLAND KREATUREZ.

The festival runs from 11am-11:30pm and admission is \$10.00.
